### ANNUAL SURPLUS LINE BROKER PREMIUM TAX FILINGS

*From DOI Newsletter May 2024*

In 2024, there was significant improvement in the percentage of surplus line brokers adhering to annual premium tax filing deadlines. Compared to the previous year, where only 77.31% filed before March 1 and 91.57% by April 1, this year saw a notable improvement, with 90.10% filing by March 1 and 97.28% by April 1. The Idaho Department of Insurance attributes this improvement to the commendable dedication of Idaho's brokers, alongside collaborative efforts between the Department and the Surplus Line Association of Idaho to provide enhanced guidance.
